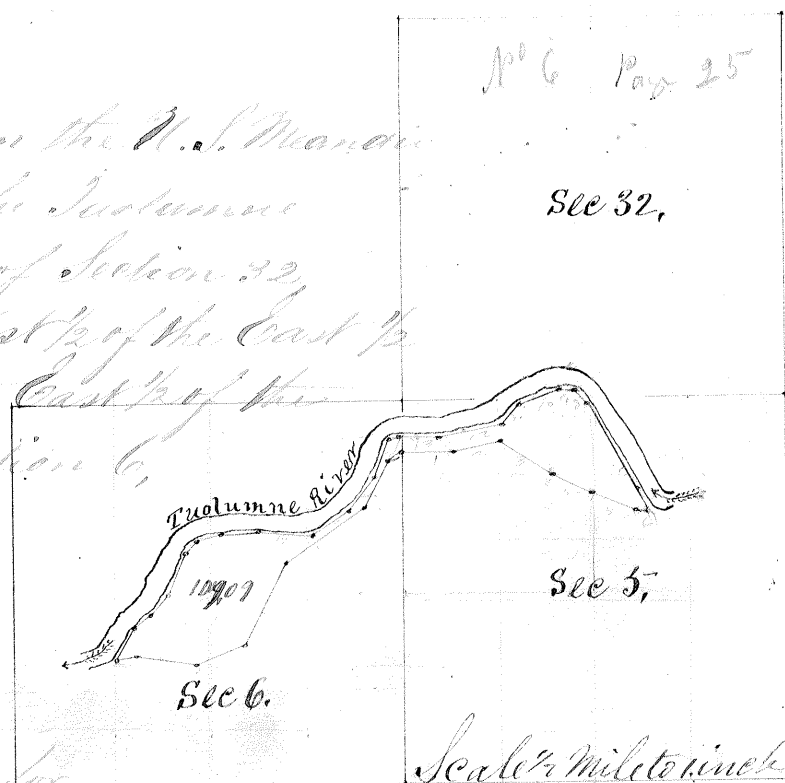

Field Notes.



Beginning at Meander Post on line between Sections 5 & 6. Thence run on U.S. Meander line N 87 1/2° E 10.50 ch, N 77 1/2° E 10.00 ch, S 59° E 13.00 ch, S 66° E 9.00 ch, S 68° E 10.00 ch, S 66 1/2° E 2.11 ch to the left bank of the Tuolumne River. Meander down stream. Run N 28 1/4° W 25.73 ch, N 32 1/4° W 3.76 ch, N 87 1/2° W 3.00 ch, S 69 1/4° W 9.59 ch, S 43° W 5.45 ch, S 20 1/4° W 13.57 ch, N 88 1/2° W 7.20 ch, S 55° W 2.21 ch, S 19° W 7.34 ch, S 44 1/2° W 9.22 ch, S 57° W 8.72 ch, N 88° W 11.29 ch, S 83 1/4° W 7.60 ch, S 71° W 3.05 ch, S 48° W 3.42 ch, S 26 1/2° W 9.63 ch, S 39 1/4° W 3.22 ch, S 51 1/4° W 4.05 ch, S 31° W 7.55 ch to the U.S. Meander line. Thence run on U.S. Meander line N 87 1/2° E 4.68 ch, S 87 1/2° E 12.00 ch, N 69° E 11.00 ch, N 26 1/2° E 19.31 ch, N 55 1/4° E 20.00 ch, N 28 1/4° E 11.00 ch, N 57 1/4° E 3.27 ch to the place of beginning.

Run by the true Meridian. Magnetic Variation 15° 25' East. Surveyed in accordance with the Act of the Legislature concerning Swamp and Overflowed Lands, approved April 28th 1850, and the instruction of the Surveyor General.
