# Introduction

# Before We Begin

Before we begin learning the principles and steps to achieving the skill of fast and quality article writing, let us touch briefly on why it is so important that you be able to write articles fast. I'm sure that you already know why articles are so important, and how content plays its role as the lifeblood of the internet. The internet is all about information, and as information marketers, we need to take advantage of that and give out information in both quantity and quality in order to make the best profits online.

Regardless of the level of skill of the individual, however, writing articles is one of the toughest activities that internet marketers have to go through. Indeed, it is even the leading cause for beginners to internet marketing quitting half-way through. People hate writing articles, and it is definitely a fact. If you really wanted to write, you would have become a writer instead of an internet marketer, no? 😊

However, you still need to learn this art because writing articles is what helps us to rank in the search engines, it's what help customers to understand what we have to offer and why they should buy from us. And every second that you spend putting off your article writing is another second wasted, and we all know that time is money.

Just imagine for a second that you have already acquired the skill of writing articles in 3 to 5 minutes. Do you think you would still put off article writing then? Let's say that you are someone who outsources his or her articles for others to produce. Outsourcing itself takes some time, and it takes money too. On rough estimation, let's say that it takes you two to three minutes just to log into your account and type out an email telling your outsource team what you need in terms of content. In the same manner, let's say that you are able to write a 400-word article in two to three minutes. Wouldn't you be saving yourself a ton of money in that respect if you just wrote the article yourself?

That's one of the main advantages of being able to write articles quickly yourself. You save yourself time and money while giving yourself more convenience and control. It's understandable that you would hate article writing if it took you an hour or more to write a single article, but if you could do it in but a few minutes, I'm sure you would change your mind about it.

This book serves to provide you with simple solutions for helping you to churn out your articles faster and to help you achieve that content-producing finesse that you desire. And the good thing is, the more you do it, the better you will get. Very soon, you will be able to create articles at neck breaking speeds too! Of course, in this book, we will be covering the production of 400-word articles as they are the most commonly needed, but you can apply the same principles to articles of any length.

In the next chapter, we will be covering the basic principles of article writing, including the things that are really slowing you down. Once you understand these principles and put the steps that I have recommended into practice, you will be able to become a naturally fast writer.



# Basic Principles of Fast Writing

In this chapter, we will cover the key concepts of fast writing, including points on the various factors that are slowing you down. If you correct even one of the problems related with these four factors, you will be able to boost your article writing speed significantly.

So, what are the main reasons that might be contributing to your lack in speed when writing articles? This can easily be addressed by the key components of writing articles. These key components are:

1. Research Speed
2. Structuring Speed
3. Typing Speed
4. Personal Mood

These are the four main points that affect the production of every article. Even if you have never considered these points before, I'm sure just by looking at them you will understand why they make up the four essential elements of writing.

In order to better understand how these four key elements tie together, consider the following fact: 90% of all content in the world is but filler, and only 10% of the content makes up the essential points.

So, let's say that you are planning on writing a 400-word article. Out of those 400-words, only 40 words make up the key points of the article (10%), and the other 360 words make up the filler of the article (90%). Filler includes phrases that help to progress the main points of the article, such as “as a result of”, “and because of that”, “with respect to the previous point”, etc.

However, filler is necessary if you want to make your article understandable and well-presented in the eyes of your readers. But that doesn't change the fact that the main points of the article are of much greater importance than the filler. If you are able to get the main points of the article quickly, filler isn't all that hard to put in. Sometimes you won't even need to put it in yourself, and I will be giving you some techniques for doing that in the later chapters. ;)

Now, going back to our 400-word example, we mentioned that only 40 words make up the most important aspects of the article. Think to yourself, how long would it take for you to write 40 words? Not very long right?

However, the things that you need to do before you are able to produce those 40 words are researching for your main points, structuring those points, and typing them out on your computer. Once you have done that, putting in your filler is simple. Of course, this all ties in to your personal mood as well, because if you don't feel like writing, you just won't write at all.

In the next modules, we cover how you can improve your writing in all of the important factors mentioned above, as well as giving you powerful tools and techniques that will aid you tremendously in your progress.

## Module I - Research Speed

# The Importance of Research Speed

The amount of research you will need to put into your article varies depending on how much you know about that topic off the top of your head. However, in many cases, we don't know anything about our topic at all, and the result of that is that we will need to do some research.

Doing enough research is very important as you want your article to have enough information such that your readers will be attracted to what you are writing about. However, there is also the need to minimize the research time. If you want to be able to achieve article writing speeds of five minutes or less, you can't waste too much time researching. However, you will still need to do a decent amount of research. That's why addressing the issue of research speed is so important...

By the time you finish going through this module, you will be able to quickly finish the research phase of your article writing in one minute or so. You certainly shouldn't take longer than that. Let's continue on to the next section to identify exactly how much research work you will need to do for your particular article.

# How Much Research Do We Need?

So, how will you know how much research you will need for your article? We can easily boil this down to a simple rule of thumb. Let's take some simple averages in order for us to further understand the concept of how much researched information we will need for your articles.

The first average we will take is the average of sentences. On average, a simple sentence will have about 10 to 15 words. Let us take 12 words per sentence as a reasonable approximation.

Next, let us take the average of paragraphs. There are two ways we can do this. We can start with the number of paragraphs we think we want, or we can start with a very good estimation on the number of words. On average, let's say that a simple paragraph should have about 80 words. Too many words per paragraph are no good and too little would make it look less like an article. For a 400-word article, we can then say that we have about 5 paragraphs.

A 400-word article will have about  $400/12$  words per sentence = 33 sentences. For simplicity's sake, let's round that up to 35 sentences per 400-word article. And lastly, since we want about 5 paragraphs, then we should have  $35 \text{ sentences} / 5 \text{ paragraphs} = 7$  sentences per paragraph.

Up until now, we have been discussing the theory of dividing an article into paragraphs and sentences in order to determine how much research we

should do for a particular article. If you are not interested in that, you can skip it if you like. However, we will just be taking the results from our simple calculations previously in order to determine the overall layout of the article we will be making.

From the above averages we have taken, we can take a 400-word article to be having 5 paragraphs with 7 sentences per paragraph. The first and last paragraph should be the introduction and conclusion. That leaves us with 3 paragraphs for talking about the key points. Each key point should take up one paragraph. So, for our research, we will need to find three key points and a couple of additional supporting points for each of those three key points.

With 7 sentences per paragraph, let's just say we will need to find three supporting points for each key point. Thus, these are the things that our research will focus on looking for if you are doing 400-word articles:

**Key Point #1**

- **3 Supporting Points**

**Key Point #2**

- **3 Supporting Points**

**Key Point #3**

- **3 Supporting Points**

We won't need to do any research for the introduction and conclusion. All we need to look for are the points needed to fill the other areas.

# Where to Gather Research Information

Now that we know what we are looking for, the question is often where to look for these points. Well, the simple number one answer that should come to mind is Google. There are many places where you will be able to gather information, but I suggest that you limit your research to only a few websites in order to increase your speed and efficiency.

I often find that just using Google is much more than enough to help you get exactly what you are looking for. So, let's just keep things as simple as we can and use Google for our research.

Once you have determined the topic that you are going to write about, go to Google.com and type in your search phrase. Once you have done that, click and open the first three results in new tabs. You can open your results in new tabs by holding down the CTRL key while you click on the link with your mouse.

For example, let's say that I want to write an article on acne solutions. I type the keyword 'acne solutions' into the Google search box, and I find that that the top three results are acneteam.com, youradultacnesolution.com, and acnesolutions.org.

I open each of those results in new tabs in my browser, and I take one key point and three supporting points from each of those three results. From the first

result, which is [acneteam.com](http://acneteam.com), I take the following key point and supporting points:

**Key Point #1 - Chemical Treatments**

- **ProActiv:** renewing, revitalizing, repairing
- **Accutane:** strong, prescription based, side effects
- **Retin-a:** treat acne, scars, wrinkles, etc.

Within a matter of seconds, I have gathered my first key point, along with three supporting points for that main point from the first website result I got from Google. Now I just simply repeat the process with the other two search results from [youradultacnesolution.com](http://youradultacnesolution.com) and [acnesolutions.org](http://acnesolutions.org) and I get the following key points:

**Key Point #2 – Prevention**

- **No touching or squeezing affected area**
- **Clean the face regularly and gently**
- **Be careful when buying makeup**

**Key Point #3 – Changes based on the individual**

- **Everyone is different**
- **Effectiveness depends on individual**
- **Consider what your needs are and the severity**



# Turbo-charged Information Gathering

As we have shown in the previous chapter, gathering information for your article doesn't have to be tough. The first time you try it, it may take a bit longer, but the more you do it, the better and faster you will get at it. As they say, practice makes perfect. So in this section, I would like to give you additional tools to help you along your way, and also an action plan that if you follow on a daily basis, you will be sure to be able to gather all your researched data within a minute or less.

In the bonuses section of this product, you will find that I have included for you an instant article research software for free. All you have to do is to insert your main topic into the box, press 'Go', and it will generate the results from the front page of Google right there for you. I hope that you find this useful as it will further save your time, since you won't have to take the time to open the results in Google in new tabs.

You may choose to use this in your daily activities, or if you find that you enjoy using Google just find, then just stick with that. ☺ Also, there may be times that you find Google is not able to give you the results you are looking for. This does not happen to me often, but if this is the case, then the second best choices for you would be to refer to Wikipedia, or article directories such as Ezinearticles.

Now without further ado, here is your action plan for helping you to boost your article research speed like never before. ;)

Your action plan:

1. Every day, list out five topics that you would like to gather information on. These can be random topics, or topics related to what you are going to write about that day.
2. For each of those topics, type them into Google, and get three key points along with three supporting points for each of those key points, from the top three results in Google. Alternatively, use the research software.
3. List all of those key points and supporting points as fast as you can onto your computer. By the time you are done, you should have the important elements ready for 5 articles. Great!
4. Keep on repeating this every day. After one or two weeks, you will be able to easily complete the research stage of article writing in 30 to 60 seconds. It's a very simple exercise and will only take you 2 to 7 minutes to do every day.

Make sure you keep repeating this every day until you can do it as naturally as breathing. If not, you will find that the research phase will greatly slow you down later on.

# Summary of the Research Steps

- Determine the main topic of the article you want to write about.
- Type that main topic into Google and get the results.
- Open the top three results in new tabs, and take one point and three supporting points from each of those three results.
- Alternatively, you may use the article research software that I have provided.
- If you are writing a 400-word article, you will only need three main points.
- If you are writing a longer or shorter article, you will need more or less, depending on the number of words you are aiming for.

That's all for this section. In the next section, we will cover the concept of structuring your article in order to help you achieve article producing speeds of five minutes or less! 😊

Additionally, in the next section, I will also be giving you a method on how to reduce your required research time to zero, and how to take advantage of this method. Look out for this!

## Module 2 - Structuring Speed

# The Importance of Structuring

Now that you have got the basics of article research down, you will be able to structure your articles much quicker. In fact, we have already done a bit of structuring in the previous module. However, now we are going to take it to the next level.

You know that for a 400-word article, you will need to have an introduction, three paragraphs covering three key points, and a conclusion. One of the hardest parts about article writing is structuring your thoughts. If you had tried to write an article without doing the research method that I had talked about in the previous module, you would have found that you had an awfully difficult time knowing what to write about.

This is because you don't have a structure in your mind of the direction you want your article to proceed in. In order to improve your article writing speed, we want to reduce the amount of thinking and guessing to nearly zero. Like I said before, we want article writing to be as easy and natural as drinking water and eating pizza. Thus, having a great structure and system enables you to do this with ease.

The main importance of this is that it will allow you to write high quality articles quickly and without thinking, and you will be able to write articles out of habit because of the implementation of such a system.

# The Basics of Structuring

Once you have gathered your information from the research phase, you have already put it into a type of structure, which is somewhat like this:

**Introduction**

**Key Point #1**

**Key Point #2**

**Key Point #3**

**Conclusion**

While learning about researching, we have already covered a bit about structuring, which is great. However, this is just the structuring of the overall article. We want to be able to structure the sentences that you are going to be writing as well if you truly want to achieve fast writing speeds. By structuring your sentences, you will be able to reduce your article production speed down to 2 to 5 minutes.

Remember that we said that 90% of all articles are filler. If you can eliminate the filler in the articles, you will be able to reduce your writing speed tremendously. Imagine if all you needed to do was to put in the main points for your article. All the conjunctions, adjectives, etc. have already been done for you. How simple article writing would be!

The best way to do this would be to use a style of structuring your sentences that is based on templates. You would use the templates to account for all the filler that you would need to put in, and in the end all you would need to insert would be your key points.

The idea of templating articles is not a new one, and has been used for a while, though it is not that widely known. Even Disney templates their movies with the same scenes but different characters! Creating your own article templates is easy, and you would be able to do it for any style of article that you consistently write about. All you have to do is to identify the common style that your articles have and to create templates for those styles.

Let me give you an example based on the previous acne solutions example that we discussed about previously. Perhaps we wanted to write an article that gave general information on acne solutions. We could template your article like so, as shown below. Take note that this is a template that I created with respect to a problem-solution scenario:

“Perhaps you are one of the millions of people in the general population who are looking for \_\_\_\_\_. Indeed, \_\_\_\_\_ is a common problem faced by many, and there has been a lack of result when it comes to finding solutions to this problem. In this article, we want to discuss about the overall aspect of \_\_\_\_\_ in general, and to give you some informative ideas on the most popularly searched for areas of the topic, namely \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_.”

Once you have templates of your own, you will be able to easily create fresh new articles just by inserting the main points into your template. However, of course if you just use a template like this, you will be having quite a lot of duplicate content in your articles. The simple solution would be to change a few phrases in the sentences of the article.

For example, for the part “Perhaps you are one of the millions of people in the general population who are looking for...”, you might change it to “Maybe you are one of the many people in the world who are looking for...”. It is a simple and easy process which shouldn’t take more than a few seconds at most.

If you want a more powerful solution, you could easily spin every word or sentence of your template by using an article spinner in order to help you achieve quick results. After that, it would be all downhill from there. I won’t be going into detail about article spinning in this eBook, but I just wanted to let you know the powerful options that are accessible to you.



# Structuring & Templating Made Easy

Now, perhaps you might find creating your own template a bit difficult. There are several ways around this. First is that you take an existing article that you already have, take out the main points and leave the overall structure intact. You can even take articles from article directories to be the base of your template. Just make sure you change it enough such that it becomes unique content. Then you can just fill in the main points with new ones each time.

The next way that you might consider would be for you to invest in an automated article templating solution such as [Instant Article Factory](#). Using such a service will enable you to gain access to unique pre-made templates that you can use instantly to generate articles. By using the art of templating, you will greatly reduce the amount of work you do, while simultaneously increasing your article producing speed. Even if you have not mastered any other method, just using templates will enable you to produce articles in 2 to 5 minutes with ease.

However, there are two ways you can use templates to help you improve your article writing speed, namely the direct way and the indirect way. The direct way means that you just use the templates as-is, and insert your key points into the article, while changing a few of the template's words and phrases here and there. The indirect way means that you just use the templates to help you practice your article writing, and once you have reached a certain level, you don't need the template itself anymore. You will be able to type out the whole

template by heart, including the main points along with it, each time changing the words and phrases as you see fit instantly.

The indirect method is a good way to go if you don't want to be reliant on templates forever, and you want to be able to recreate the whole article in one sitting off the top of your head. The key to lightning-fast article writing is to reduce the element of thought to nearly zero, and to make writing articles into as much of a natural habit as possible. In order to do this, you will need to follow the same structure every single time, such that you won't need to think at all. All you would need to do would be to type out the whole structure of the article that you memorized off the top of your head, including the key points directly.

Perhaps I wasn't so clear in that previous paragraph, so let me say it in more practical terms. This is what you do... Create a very generic template for yourself that can be used for writing any type of article with the fill in the blanks sort of thing. Now that you have a template, every time you create a new article, don't just fill in the template with your key points directly. Re-type every sentence in the template again from scratch, and insert your key points you're your article as you type it out.

By doing this many times, you are practicing the structuring of your article, and you will soon be able to produce your articles quickly without thinking and without the template, just like drinking water and eating pizza. This is the indirect method of using templates to assist you in improving your article writing speed. If you need some assistance on templating your articles on

your own, a simple way to do it is to break down your article into sentences and to see what you can fit into each sentence. Remember in the previous module, we determined that one 400-word article would have about 35 sentences, with 5 paragraphs? So, you can break down your article like this:

### **Paragraph 01 - Introduction**

Sentence 01 – Introducing the topic  
Sentence 02 – Filler  
Sentence 03 – Why the topic is of importance  
Sentence 04 – Filler  
Sentence 05 – The Benefit of reading this article  
Sentence 06 – Filler  
Sentence 07 – Three main points covered by the article

### **Paragraph 02 – Key Point #1**

Sentence 08 – Introduce the first key point  
Sentence 09 – First supporting point  
Sentence 10 – Filler  
Sentence 11 – Second supporting point  
Sentence 12 – Filler  
Sentence 13 – Third supporting point  
Sentence 14 – Filler

**Etc.**

By doing this, it makes it easy for you to see where you are going to insert your main points, where you are going to insert your filler, etc. In short, it helps you to create your templates much more easily.

Creating templates is an easy way to boost your article writing speed, but take note that the quality of your article will be based on the quality of your template. Thus, make sure you create a good one. ;)

# Additional Tips and Points

In the previous chapters, we talked about how structuring your article using templates helps you to reduce the amount of time you need to spend creating your article. However, apart from reducing the amount of time you need to spend thinking, structuring and filling, the use of templates also allows you to take advantage of already researched information.

If you've been doing the exercises in Module 1, you would have found that you were able to drastically decrease the amount of time needed to find the key points for your article. However, I also mentioned at the end of that module that I would be teaching you a method to take advantage of zero research time. 😊

The reason why I mention it in this module is because it goes well with using templates and that is the best way to take advantage of it. Of course, the situation where you would not need to do any research for your particular topic would be if you had already done the research before or if you already know the topic thoroughly by heart. You can use this to your advantage to further reduce the necessary amount of time for producing an article.

So, let's say that you are already an expert with regards to acne solutions, or you have already done previous research for that in the past. If that is the case, then you won't need to waste your time doing research once again. All you have to do is take the results of your previous research or experience, and present the information in a different form.

Let's take our previous example of acne solutions again. You did research on the topic, and you found a lot of good points. You made yourself one article from that information. Now, you can take the information and make another article quickly and easily using templates and your key points. So if your previous article was about acne solutions, you could take the main points you already have and use them to write another related article. Take another keyword with a similar meaning such as pimple solutions, or zit solutions, and you can easily rewrite another article with the same points quickly and easily.

The benefit of this is that it eliminates your research time, and allows you to create new and unique articles that are targeting other related keywords around your niche. The key is to reuse the same points and rewrite some words or phrases here and there in your templates. For this reason, it would also be good if you had a number of different templates to add variety to your articles.

Another great way to repurpose the existing information you have to create new articles quickly is to take your article and rewrite it so as to target different specifications of people. For example, with an article about acne solutions, you could easily take the same article and reword it slightly and let the article be about acne solutions for teenagers, or acne solutions for young adults, or acne solutions for women, or acne solutions for Hollywood actresses, etc.

Using templates is a great way to reuse existing research information and to quickly produce unique articles targeting a variety of different keywords and

circumstances. Doing this, you reduce your article research time to zero and your article writing time by 80 to 90%.

So, now that we are done with that, let me give you your action steps for this section.

Your action plan:

1. Break down your article by paragraphs and sentences as shown previously in order to help you outline and create your template. You can have different templates for different types of articles and different niches as well.
2. Create templates that you can use for your article marketing efforts. All you have to do is create the filler, while leaving some blank sentences or phrases which you will fill in for your particular niche or situation. Alternatively, you may want to purchase [Instant Article Factory](#) which comes preloaded with templates for you.
3. Take the researched information you got from your daily practice of module one and insert it into the template you have created. Retouch your template with some new words or phrases here and there. Once you have mastered this step, you will be able to create articles within a few minutes.
4. You may continue using your templates as is, or you may want to practice typing out each and every word from your template each time you create a new article in order to make the creation of such articles second nature and to reduce your reliance on the templates.

5. Practice creating another new article with the information you have currently researched, while targeting a different keyword, or specializing the article for a particular audience or target market.

Well, that's all for this section. Before you move on to the next section, a great tip that I would like to give you is that you can move through your templates and change things quickly by holding down the CTRL key while you are moving through the articles using your keyboard.

Also, you can quickly select the blanks you have made in your template by holding down the SHIFT and CTRL keys at the same time, and just type in your phrase or sentence in order to replace them. Try it and you will get what I meant. 😊

# Summary of the Structuring Steps

- Structuring is important because it helps you to get your thoughts organized and reduces the amount of time you spend thinking and guessing. The less you have to think, the less time you waste.
- After organizing your research points which will give you the overall structure of the article, you can create a template that organizes your paragraphs and sentences.
- Divide your article into paragraphs and sentences with brief summaries to help you create your own templates which you can use to make articles quickly and easily.
- Once the templates are done, just fill in the blanks with your main points while changing a few words and phrases in the template to get a unique article quickly.
- You can retype your templates word-for-word each time if you want to memorize your article template and make it second nature.
- You can create new unique articles even quicker and eliminate the need for research by simply changing the keywords used, and targeting.

In the next section, we will talk about a very simple way to improve both your article creation speed and overall efficiency in just five minutes a day! 😊



## Module 3 – Typing Speed

# Why You Need To Improve Typing Speed

Well, you probably don't need me to tell you this, but the speed at which you are able to produce articles is directly tied to your typing speed. If you can only type at speeds of 20 words per minute, then it would be much more difficult for you to create 400-word articles in 5 minutes or less. But, it is not just about creating articles. Everything you do online requires you to do some amount of typing, from entering your URL into the address bar of your internet browser, to typing out the emails you want to send to your customers.

I have included this short module on typing speed in order to help you cover this blind-spot that many people overlook. If you practice the exercises included in this module, not only will you be able to create articles much faster, but your overall productivity will benefit as well.

First, before we begin let us have a look at how fast you have to be able to type in order to create a 400-word article in 5 minutes from scratch:

$$400 \text{ words} / 5 \text{ minutes} = 80 \text{ words per minute!}$$

Now, that is if you create articles from scratch. If you use the templates you have created from the previous module, you won't need to type that much. So, let's say that the templates that you create help you to fill in about 200 out of

the 400 words you will need to produce, as a conservative estimate. This means that you will need to type at speeds of:

$$200 \text{ words} / 5 \text{ minutes} = 40 \text{ words per minute!}$$

Well, that's a lot easier to achieve. However, it's very easy to improve your typing speed in just a few minutes a day. So, it would be in your best interest to increase your typing speed and to create articles in just 2 or 3 minutes. ;)

So, let's begin with some concepts and methods that you can use to easily improve your typing speed. In the next section, you will learn two schools of thoughts when it comes to improving your typing speed, and which one you will learn about.

# Two Schools of Thought

In general, I have found that there are two schools of thought for improving your typing speed. The first method to improve your typing speed is to practice typing as fast as you can. The second method to improve your typing speed is to practice typing as slow as you can.

Well, this report is not about learning to type, so I won't tell you everything about typing here. In this report, you will learn how to utilize the first method to quickly improve your typing speed. Thus, you will be learning to type as fast as you can. ;)

In general, practice makes perfect is the key concept when it comes to the fast typing practice school of thought. The more you type fast, the faster you can type. This is the same principle that is incorporated into most typing games.

However, you will always want to practice typing at your fastest. And the time when you are the fastest, regardless of whether it is typing or running a marathon is when you are in a competition. Normally, you will find athletes performing at their highest level and giving it their all when they are putting it on the line and competing with others. You will often find that professionals imagine themselves to be in the very midst of a competitive battleground while they are practicing in order to get themselves used to performing at a higher level.

Thus, in the next section, we will be discussing about how you can hold your own mini-typing competitions daily in order to help you acquire much higher typing speeds in a short amount of time. 😊

# Typing Speed Training

In the previous section, we discussed about why you should engage yourself in typing speed competitions daily in order to improve your typing speed. Of course, I won't be asking you to hold daily typing competitions at your home. That would be too tough. :P

When I first started, I used this site to improve my typing speed, and after a few weeks, my typing speed went up from 50 to 70 words per minute, all the way up to 80 to 100 words per minute. # What About Your Mood?

Ok, so in the previous sections we have already covered the key points on the various important areas that you will need to address if you want to be able to create articles quickly and easily. However, all of the previous items do not help you in any way if you just don't feel like creating articles at all. You might have the potential, but you might not feel like typing right now, and you keep putting it off until the next year.

Being in the right mood is actually something very important to typing. Just a few changes can either put you in the mood, or it can put you out of it. In this section, we will be covering some important methods for helping you to always get into the "writing machine" mode quickly and easily. You don't have to do a lot of work in order to do this. It is quite simple really. ☺

If you just follow the few simple steps I have listed in this module, you will find yourself churning out articles like crazy and at any time you wish. So, let's go onto the next section where I will show you how you can put yourself in the mood to create articles with the push of a button!

# Factors That Affect the Mood

Firstly, let's talk about the various factors that affect the mood. Actually, there are probably a ton of different factors that would do so, but the ones that I have found to be most prominent are the working environment, the time of day, and the background ambience.

You might be surprised to hear this, but different working environments can positively or negatively affect your ability to write. Try different working environments in order to find the one that works best for you. Once you have found this ideal environment, you will find yourself able to churn out articles like it is nothing. For me, I found that I was most unproductive in my bedroom, while the living room gives me the best place for working on my laptop and for creating articles. For you, it might be different. Perhaps your ideal place could be that coffee shop across the street where you normally frequent. ;)

Next, the time of day is quite important. This can be due to many reasons. One of the main reasons is due to interruptions and distractions. The other reason is because you just feel more of in a writing mood at different times. For me, I'm a morning person. I feel that I get the most work done in the early morning right after I wake up. For you, it might be in the dead of the night. Try writing your articles at different times of the day to find out which works best for you.

Last but not least, the thing that I want to talk about is the background ambience. Well, what I really want to talk about is the music you normally play in the background. Some people may require absolute silence while they are writing their articles so that they can concentrate and get the best results. Others may prefer to have soft, classical music. Find the music that best suits your working style, and you will find the articles flowing quickly and steadily.

They have a variety of albums that put your brain into different states, including states for great concentration, increased thinking speed, and others. I have used this series to great effect, and have always managed to get a lot of my work done more quickly and efficiently than I would normally.

I would suggest you to try out their Think Fast albums, which help to get your thinking speed in an accelerated level, and you will find that you think and do your work a lot faster than you normally do. ;)

In the next section, I show you a quick trick for putting yourself with the click of a button.

# A Quick Trick

In this section, I want to show you how you can get in the mood for anything quickly and easily, and all you have to do is to click a button if you so desire. The concept of this section is based on two things.

First it is based on the concept of practice makes perfect. Second, it is based on the concept that excellence is not an act, but a habit. So, let's begin...

In order to carry out this trick, first you have to find a trigger. Let's take for example that your trigger may be a small notepad file on your computer. What this trick will enable you to do is, every time you pull the trigger, which in this case is to open that notepad file, you will automatically start writing your next article right away!

Of course this doesn't happen by itself, naturally. But you can condition yourself to do so through practice and habit. All you have to do is keep repeating the process several times over a few days, and it will become like second nature.

So here's what you do... Create a notepad file on your desktop, insert some text, like "Start writing article now", and save the file. Once you have done that, just close the file for now. Now that the file has been created, we can begin. Are you ready? 😊

Click on the file and open it now. And the moment the file opens, rush to begin writing your next article. Don't even wait for one second, just start

writing or researching for your next article. Once you have written about two sentences, just stop right there, and close everything down. Now go and do something else for a while.

Then while doing something else, interrupt yourself and click on the file again to open it. Once the file has opened, go right back into article writing mode again. Write a few sentences and then stop and let yourself be interrupted again, and so on. The purpose of this is to practice conditioning yourself to react to a certain trigger or stimuli. Keep on practicing this action again and again until it becomes a habit, so that the moment you open the magic file you start getting into article writing mode. You see where this is going?

After a while of doing this continually for a few days, you will find that it becomes second nature. And the only thing you have to do to get into article writing mode is to click on the file on the desktop. Of course, that's not the only way you can trigger your mood. You can also set the trigger to different things.

For example, if clicking on a file on your desktop is not as classy as you would like, you could make the trigger to be the moment you turn on your computer. So, the moment you turn on your computer, you start writing an article from start to finish. Keep on practicing this habit, and it will become so that every time you turn on your computer, you will begin creating an article. This is a good way to practice and condition yourself to get in the mood for writing articles.

The hardest part about writing an article or any piece of content is often the area of getting started. Once you have an easy way to get started, then you won't have as much trouble continuing. The inertia of the task will keep you going to completion.

Your action plan:

1. Try writing your articles in various environments, at different times of day, and with different music in the background to see which one is the most beneficial for you.

3. Find a suitable trigger that you will want to use to instantly bring you into an article writing mode. Keep on practicing and conditioning yourself to react to that trigger so that every time you carry out that particular action, you start work on your next article.

- You can alter your mood easily by changing the environment you work in, the time of day you create your articles, and the background ambience, with particular attention given to background music.

- Choose a trigger, and practice starting to write or research for articles the moment the trigger happens until you finish the article.

Don't pause to think about changing a sentence or to modify things sentence by sentence. If you want to edit, wait until you finish writing first. Just keep going until you are done so that you don't break the flow!
